CHRB RULE #1688 MEETING

A meeting took place at 12:00 p.m. in the Santa Anita Conference Room. This meeting was regarding California Stewards' interpretation and enforcement of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop). The following people attended this meeting that lasted nearly two (2) hours.

A few weeks ago an eight (8) question survey was offered to all licensed jockeys in California. These questions had to do with public perception, stewards' enforcement/interpretation, owners/trainers feelings and racing safety regarding CHRB Rule #1688 (Use of the Riding Crop). The crucial issue of the meeting was what criteria California Stewards use to interpret the language 'chance to respond' as featured in the text of CHRB Rule #1688. The severity of penalty's, especially at Los Alamitos was also addressed. A good 'back and forth' was had by all.

RIDING RULE (CHRB #1699) MEETING

A second meeting was held after the 'riding crop' meeting. The attendees of this meeting were similar to the earlier meeting except there were no jockeys' or Jockeys' Guild management in attendance. This rule is in the process of being implemented as soon as the California Office of Administrative Law (OAL) allows as such. Trainer James Cassidy (CTT) spoke to the parties assembled about the position/feelings the members of his organization (California Thoroughbred Trainers) have with regard to the upcoming implementation of this rule. The 'new rule' will state that California Stewards shall issue a minimum of a two (2) day riding suspension for a careless riding violation (CHRB Rule #1699). A recent notice indicates implementation of this change is set for July 1, 2018.

SANTIAGO GONZALEZ RULING

Jockey Santiago Gonzalez failed to appear for film review during the reserved 10:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. time slot. He was scheduled to review the third race from Sunday, April 8, 2018. The Stewards issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #138

Jockey SANTIAGO GONZALEZ is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to attend film review within designated time) on April 13, 2018.

EVIN ROMAN FILM REVIEW

Jockey Evin Roman appeared in our office to review his ride aboard #5 MAJESTIC JOURNEY who finished sixth in the 3rd race on Sunday, April 8, 2018. The Stewards wanted to review an incident the start of this six (6) furlong event. After a short review of a bumping incident the Stewards excused Jockey Roman as his involvement in the incident was minimal.

4/13/18³

PETER MILLER HEARING (CASE NO. 18SA0038)

The CHRB filed a complaint against Trainer Peter Miller for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1844 C(1) (Authorized Medication), Rule #1866 (Veterinarian's List), Rule #1843.1 (B) (Prohibited Drug Substances). The complaint in this case reads as follows.

On January 15, 2018 the horse 'Te Amo Mamo' trained by Peter Miller conducted an official work for removal from the veterinarian's list. The official blood sample #NC35105 was analyzed by U.C. Davis Laboratory was found to contain the Class 4 Drug Phenylbutazone (2.65 ug/ml).

Trainer Peter Miller did not appear at the hearing. He was represented by Private Veterinarian Joseph Dowd. CHRB Investigator Greg Icamen (first day on the job) attended. Michelle Derieg transcribed the proceedings. CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton presented a twenty-three (23) page complaint packet at this formal hearing. Steward Sawyer chaired the hearing. Testimony was given. Documents were marked for identification and put into evidence. The hearing was closed and a decision is to follow.

VETERINARIAN CHANGE

Track Veterinarian Dana Stead is off this three (3) day race week due to personal reasons. Will Farmer DVM will fill in.

4/13/18⁵

FIRST RACE INQUIRY /OBJECTION/DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of this race in order to examine the actions of the first three (3) finishers in the final 1/8th of a mile. There was also a jockey's objection in this race. The horses involved were first place finisher #4 HACKLETO (Edwin Maldonado), second place finisher #3 OREJAS (Franklin Ceballos) and third place finisher #5 ROMAN TIZZY (Evin Roman).

Race replays show original first place finisher #4 HACKLETO drift out continuously from the 1/8th pole to the wire. This action not only herds out second place finisher #3 OREJAS, but causes it to change paths to stay off of heels. The Stewards also looked at third place finisher #5 ROMAN TIZZY who was beaten 2 ¼ lengths for second place. The Stewards felt the interference to that horse was minimal and did not cost him a placing. However the interference to second place finisher #3 OREJAS was quite significant. After film review,

speaking to the jockey's and reviewing all camera angles the Stewards, in a unanimous decision, disqualified #4 HACKLETON and placed him second. Jockey Edwin Maldonado was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

NADINE ANDERSON COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 18SA0771)

This case was scheduled to be heard yesterday April 13. Owner Nadine Anderson failed to appear. Maria Delao representing EF 1 Farms did appear at our office for this hearing. The complaint reads as follows.

Owner Nadine Anderson is indebted to EF 1 Farms for board and care of eighty-two (82) thoroughbred horses. Total \$49,263.00. For failing to appear at the hearing the Stewards issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #139

Owner NADINE ANDERSON having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility - \$49,263.00 to Eric Yohan DBA EF1 Farms) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of NADINE ANDERSON are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), NADINE ANDERSON is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

LANCE HELLUM COMPLAINT (CASE NO.180061)

Trainer LANCE HELLUM appeared in our office today to have a formal hearing regarding alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct). The complaint reads as follows.

On February 26, 2018 0440 Hrs. Trainer Lance Hellum physically attacked a groom that works for Patrick Gallagher (Isauro Del Cid). The assault was captured on Santa Anita security surveillance cameras. Apparently, Trainer Lance Hellum left the barn for a few days and went to Bakersfield. When Lance Hellum returned to barn his two horses didn't have water and feed. Lance Hellum was under the impression that Isauro Garcia and William Quinteros were going to take care of his horses. Isauro Garcia and William Quinteros work for Patrick Gallagher. See Santa Anita Security report.

Grooms Isauro Del Cid and William Quinteros appeared at the hearing. Safety Steward Luis Jauregui translated. Both grooms denied they were ever asked to take care of 'the horses'. Also present today were CHRB Investigator Greg Icamen, Michael Valadez and Byron Carter (Santa Anita Stable Security). Michelle Derieg (Weinstein Court Reporters LLC) transcribed the proceedings. CHRB James Hamilton presented a fifteen (15) page complaint at the hearing.

A shed row video tape of the altercation, recorded by Santa Anita's state of the art surveillance system, was viewed by all at today's formal hearing. Video shows Trainer Hellum grab Groom Del Cid around the torso and attempt to body slam the wiry groom. Following testimony from several individuals, exhibits were marked for identification and moved into evidence. Decision to follow.

4/14/18³

SANTIAGO GONZALEZ FILM REVIEW

Jockey SANTIAGO GONZALEZ appeared in our office to review his ride aboard #6 Satori who finished seventh in the third race on Sunday, April 8, 2018. He was accompanied by Darrell Haire (Western Regional Manager-Jockeys' Guild) and Heriberto Rivera Jr. (Eastern Regional Manager-Jockeys' Guild) who is town for the George Woolf Award festivities Sunday at Santa Anita. This was a six (6) furlong main track event. Safety Steward Luis Jauregui assisted with translation. Film review shows #6 Satori veers in slightly at the 5 ½ furlong pole in this race. The incident was minor in nature and the respectful Jockey Gonzalez was excused with a caution.

4/14/18⁴

ROBERT FALCONE JR. COMPLAINT (CASE NO.18SA0069)

Trainer ROBERT FALCONE JR. appeared in our office for an informal hearing to address a violation of CHRB Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct). Along with the Stewards and Mr. Falcone the following people attended the hearing.

Mr. Hamilton presented a fifteen (15) page complaint packet at the hearing. The complaint itself reads as follows.

On March 12, 2018 at 1515 Hrs. gateman Dominic Caringella was holding back traffic from entering stable area because of a loose horse. A black truck began entering the stable area and gateman Dominic Caringella yelled at the driver to stop. The passenger in the truck (Trainer Robert Falcone) exited the truck and began yelling at Dominic Caringella. Robert Falcone got into Dominic Caringellas face in a threatening manner. The incident was

captured on the Santa Anita Security Surveillance camera. See Santa Anita Security Report #18-116. Trainer Robert Falcone has a prior disorderly conduct violation at Belmont Park Race Track on July 15, 2016. \$500 fine yelling at racing official in the racing office. Testimony was given from all parties present. Decision to follow.

4/14/18⁵

EDWIN MALDONADO FILM REVIEW (REF: 4/13/18⁵)

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO appeared in the Stewards' office to review his involvement in an Inquiry/Disqualification in the 1st Race yesterday April 13. He was accompanied by his agent Vic Lipton. Film review of the stretch drive of this race shows Jockey Maldonado aboard original first place finisher #4 HACKLETON who was lugging out in the stretch. Jockey Maldonado took very little corrective actions while his mount was lugging out and causing interference. He was using his riding crop (right handed) and observing a fast closing rival (#3 OREJAS-Franklin Ceballos) on the giant infield video monitor. Just before the finish, after getting out for almost an eighth of a mile, Jockey Maldonado straightened his mount. This horse was disqualified and placed second in this race. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling. Jockey Maldonado indicated he would appeal our decision.

LATS RULING #140

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO, who rode HACKLETON in the first race at Santa Anita Park on April 13, 2018 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (April 21, 22 and 26, 2018) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course and causing interference in the stretch resulting in a disqualification from first to second position. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

MIKE PENDER MEETING

CHRB Equine Medical Director Rick Arthur called for a meeting today with Trainer MIKE PENDER. Along with Dr. Arthur and the Stewards, also present this morning were CHRB Veterinarian Tim Grande and Will Farmer DVM who is working as the track veterinarian this week at Santa Anita. The equine practitioners want to start a conversation with Trainer Pender to review injuries that have occurred during workouts this meet. Mr. Pender was very receptive to the dialogue that took place. The CHRB will initiate similar meetings with trainers in the future if similar circumstances arise.

4/14/18⁷

SECOND RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards announced that there would be an inquiry into the start of this 6 ½ furlong race contested on the main track. The focus were the actions of #1 JUST BE HELD (Tyler Conner). This horse threw its head, ducked in and lost all chance of a decent placing before going on to a sixth (last) place finish. After a film review the Stewards attributed this poor start to the actions of this horse or a horse and jockey issue. In a unanimous decision #1 JUST BE HELD was declared a starter and the Stewards allowed the original placings to stand. No Change.

DESORMEAUX/DRYSDALE/OWNER DAVID WRIGHT MEETING

The Stewards had a meeting regarding the performance of the Neil Drysdale trained #1 INFOBEDAD (ARG) who did not finish (DNF) in the Grade 3 Tokyo City Cup, which was contested on the main track on Sunday, April 8, 2018. This horse was ridden that day by Jockey Kent Desormeaux INFOBEDAD (ARG) was pulled up at the 3/16ths pole (with assistance by outrider) after tiring badly in this 1 ½ mile event. Along with the Stewards present today were Trainer Neil Drysdale and Jockey Kent Desormeaux. The owner of this horse David Wright (Waldorf Racing Stables LLC) participated in the meeting via speakerphone from Philadelphia PA.

Trainer Drysdale was unhappy with the Stewards for placing this horse on our Steward's List for not finishing the race. He was also not pleased with Jockey Desormeaux as he felt he did not give his best effort. The Stewards reviewed various replay angles with both parties. INFOBEDAD (ARG) raced in second position in the early stages of this race and began to tire after Jockey Desormeaux used his riding crop approaching the far turn. INFOBEDAD (ARG) finished fifth and was beaten 19 ¾ lengths in his last race at Santa Anita (2/15/18) Prior to that he finished eighth (last) in a 2-mile race at Gulfstream Park on December 30, 2017. His last two (2) recorded workouts were April 2 where he registered a time of 116H seconds for 6 furlongs and March 26 where a workout 117Hg was shown on 'the work tab'. Both workouts were the slowest recorded at their specific distance for the day. Jockey Desormeaux was thanked for taking time out of his day to review what the Stewards unanimously felt was a good effort.

GLEN KAHN COMPLAINT (CASE #18SA0072)

The complaint in this matter reads as follows:

Dr. Ronald Magrini alleges Owner Glen Khan is indebted to him in the amount of 1,008.10 for veterinarian services.

Owner Khan failed to appear at this hearing which was scheduled yesterday, April 14, 2018. The stewards issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #141

Owner GLEN KHAN having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility - \$1,008.10 to Veterinarian Ronald Magrini) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of GLEN KHAN are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), GLEN KHAN is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

ROBERT FALCONE DECISION (REF: 4/14/18(4))

The ruling below was issued after deliberation of a hearing (CASE #18SA0069) that was heard yesterday April 14. Trainer ROBERT FALCONE demonstrated aggressive behavior to a Santa Anita stable gateman on March 12, 2018, Surveillance video shows Mr. Falcone 'get into the face' of Association Employee Dominic Caringella on this day. He has previously been fined \$500 by Belmont Park stewards for yelling at a racing official at that racetrack on July 15, 2016. The Stewards informed Mr. Falcone of the sanction below via telephone. Our decision was unanimous.

LATS RULING #142

Trainer ROBERT FALCONE, JR is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – entering restricted area without permission / aggressive behavior) on March 12, 2018 at Santa Anita Park.

4/15/18⁴

PETER MILLER DECISION (REF: 4/14/18(3))

The decision below was the result of a formal hearing (CASE #18SA0038) that was held in our office on April 13. The Stewards determined that this was Trainer Peter Millers' third Class 4 violation in a 365-day period. Trainer Miller did not appear at the hearing. He was informed of the following penalty via telephone. Our decision was unanimous.

LATS RULING #143

Trainer PETER MILLER, who worked the horse TE AMO MAMO on January 15, 2018 at Santa Anita Park is fined THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$3,500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) and #1866 (Veterinarian's List) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances) and #1844(c)(1) (Authorized Medication – phenylbutazone [2.65 ug/ml] – third offense in 365 days).
