The Santa Anita racing office was open and accepting entries for Saturday, October 14, 2017. Grant Baker was on duty in the Stewards' office.

STEWARD SUBSTITUTE

Steward LUIS JAUREGUI will be replacing Steward SCOTT CHANEY as he is out of town for the week. PAUL ATKINSON will be covering duties as the Safety Steward this week.

APRENTICE LICENSE

Apprentice Jockey RIGOBERTO SEVILLA was in our office seeking to renew his apprentice jockey license which it expired in 1993. MR. SEVILLA, the 52 year old rider, has been galloping horses since 1982 and has ridden four races and won one race. After receiving two signatures from journey men jockeys and getting a physical by the track physician we renewed his apprentice jockey license.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey MARIO GUTIEREZ was in to review Monday's fifth race in which he possibly violated the riding crop rule and review his ride down the stretch. After reviewing the video we determined he didn't violate the riding crop rule and regarding the slight contact down the stretch it didn't warrant a penalty but warranted a warning. MR. GUTIEREZ agreed he could of have done a better job.

Jockey DRAYDEN VANDYKE was also in to review Monday's fifth race for contact approaching the finish line and a possible crop violation. After reviewing the video we determined he didn't violate the riding crop rule. We did warn him because he shifted out slightly and he agreed he could of have done better.

10/13/17⁴**EXERCISE RIDER**

Exercise Rider JOSE DOMINGUEZ was in our office accompanied by Winners' Foundation Executive Director Darren Scharer to address the reason Mr. Dominguez had tested positive for methamphetamines this past Monday. Mr. Dominguez was temporarily denied access to the premises pending a hearing with us. Mr. Scharer recommended that MR. DOMINGUEZ enter a Sober Living Environment home, sign a contract with the Winners Foundation and sign a testing agreement with the CHRB. After receiving permission from Santa Anita Stable Security (Paul Nalbandian) MR. DOMINGUEZ was allowed to return to work. The CHRB will be filing a complaint in this matter.

10/13/17⁵**GARCIA RULING**

Trainer ANTONIO GARCIA was issued the following ruling for violating CHRB rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration). MR. GARCIA'S horse was found on race day being treated with a nebulizer which is not permitted on the day of the race. Mr. GARCIA'S horse was scratched. Therefore the following ruling was issued.

Ruling LATC #017

Trainer ANTONIO GARCIA, who was scheduled to start SUGARATSUNDOWN in the third race on October 9, 2017 at Santa Anita Park is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration - Treated).

SATURDAY10/14/17¹**KITCHINGMAN RULING**

The following ruling was issued to Trainer ADAM KITCHINGMAN after his horse showed up to the receiving barn with toe grabs for the fifth race (turf), which were ground off by Plater Victor Tovar. MR. KITCHINGMAN acknowledged his mistake and accepted his penalty.

Ruling LATS #018

Trainer ADAM KITCHINGMAN, who started the horse LITTLE BIT LOVELY, in the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on October 13, 2017 is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1853 (Examination Required – Improperly shod).

10/14/17²**PONY RIDER**

Pony Rider WILVER ORANTES was in our office after he was cited by the Santa Anita Stable Security for refusing to follow orders from the outriders. Mr. ORANTES was asked, by the outrider, to take his pony back to the barn because his pony and the race horse were both acting up. After being told to leave he proceeded to pony the race horse. Decision to follow.

10/14/17³**JOCKEY IN**

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE was in our office to explain why he was late to the paddock for the second race. MR. VAN DYKE stated he had to use the restroom which resulted in being late to the paddock. VAN DYKE also said he's never been late before, he apologized and said it wouldn't happen again. The following ruling was issued.

Ruling LATS# 019

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – late to paddock), before the SECOND race at Santa Anita Park on October 13, 2017.

10/14/17⁴**STEWARDS REVIEW**

We conducted a Stewards' Review after the running of the first race to examine the start when #4 CLIFTON BEACH (E. Roman) broke very slowly. After reviewing the video a few times we determined #4 broke slowly on his own and received a fair start.

10/14/17⁵**SMOOTH RACING**

Other than the Stewards' Review and a few scratches, all nine races went very smoothly.

SUNDAY10/15/17¹**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey COREY NAKATANI was in our office to review yesterday's fifth race in which it appeared he stood up on his horse (#8 HARD ARCH) approximately eighty yards before the finish line. MR. NAKATANI stated his horse felt sore and that's why he stood up early, but did not pull up and dismount. He also galloped the horse back to the Winner's Circle to be unsaddled. Film review shows Jockey NAKATANI stand up in the saddle approximately 13 strides before the finish line. While doing this #1 VOW'S SON (Tyler Connor), who was trailing #8 HARD ARCH at the time, races up the rail and defeats this eased rival by ½ length for fourth position. When questioned the next morning Vladimir Cerin trainer of HARD ARCH, stated he was going to turn the horse out for three weeks to freshen it up. Mr. Cerin was also asked if his private veterinarian examined HARD ARCH, he said no. As requested by the Stewards, the next morning Racing Veterinarian Dana Stead examined the horse, he stated the horse was sound and if it was racing today he would pass the standard physical examination. It was a unanimous decision that MR. NAKATANI cost his mount the opportunity of a better placing and the following ruling was issued.

LATS Ruling #021

Jockey COREY NAKATANI, who rode HARD ARCH in the FIFTH race at Santa Anita Park on October 14, 2017 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (October 22, 26 and 27, 2017) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1692 (Requirements for Horse, Trainer and Jockey – failure to ride his mount to the finish, costing him a better finish position).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

10/15/17²**ORANTES RULING (REF. 10/14/17²)**

After hearing the facts we determined that MR. ORANTES would receive a penalty and we issued the following ruling:

LATS Ruling #020

Pony Rider WILVER ORANTES is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to follow instructions of the outrider) at Santa Anita Park on October 12, 2017.

10/15/17³**VOIDED CLAIM**

The following claim was voided after we received notice that the Official Veterinarian had placed the horse (#2 JENSEN), who ran in the eighth race, on the Veterinarian list for being unsound. "JENSEN" will return to the barn of Trainer Doug O'Neill.

10/15/17⁴**GOOD RACING**

All nine (9) races went very well with no major issues to report other than the voided claim in the 8th race.
