ENTRY/SCRATCH DAY

The Santa Anita racing office was open today accepting entries for Saturday, April 8. Steward Scott Chaney was on duty. Eleven (11) races were drawn. One hundred six (106) horses are scheduled to start. The highlight of this day will be the \$1,000,000 (Grade 1) Santa Anita Derby where thirteen (13) horses have entered. Racing Secretary Rick Hammerle and his staff constructed a stellar card which includes five (5) additional stake races; three (3) of which are graded.

Scratches and changes for Thursday, April 6 also took place in the racing office today. There were four (4) scratches, two (2) equipment changes and one (1) jockey change submitted. All changes were activated after today's 10:00 a.m. deadline.

OFFICIAL CHANGES

Safety Steward Luis Jauregui is off this week for personal reasons. Paul Atkinson will fill in today and tomorrow. Ronald Church will fill in this weekend (Saturday and Sunday). Clerk of the Course Angel Lomelli has been off the last two (2) weeks on maternity leave. Vicki Layne filled in the last two (2) weeks. Dawn Schmid is scheduled to fill in for the remainder of Ms. Lomelli's leave.

Track Veterinarian Dana Stead is off this week for personal reasons. Will Farmer D.V.M. and Becky Fitzgerald D.V.M. are filling in for him. Dr. Farmer had difficulties with travel from Kentucky and arrived mid-card Thursday. Dr. Fitzgerald, who is the track veterinarian at the Los Alamitos Quarter Horse meet, filled in until his arrival.

SANTIAGO GONZALEZ FILM REVIEW

Jockey SANTIAGO GONZALEZ appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride in the Tokyo City Cup (\$100,000 Guaranteed-Grade 3) which was the eighth race on Sunday, April 2. Jockey Gonzalez won this race aboard the John Sadler trained #6 Hard Aces. Turning for home in this 1 ½ mile main track event Jockey Gonzalez used his riding crop five (5) consecutive times around the 3/16 marker. Gonzalez agreed this was a violation and the Stewards issued the following ruling.

RULING LATS #115

Jockey SANTIAGO GONZALEZ is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on April 2, 2017.

COREY NAKATANI FILM REVIEW

Jockey COREY NAKATANI appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #8 Temple Keys who finished fourth in the fourth race on Saturday, April 1. Jockey Nakatani was aboard #8 Temple Keys and used his riding crop four (4) consecutive times inside the 1/8th pole. In this 1 1/8 mile turf event. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

RULING LATS #116

Jockey COREY NAKATANI is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on April 1, 2017.

KERRIE CARGILL COMPLAINT (CASE NO.17SA0019)

CHRB Investigator Phil Miyazaki prepared a fourteen (14) page complaint packet against Horse Transporter Kerrie Cargill for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). Horse Transporter Donald Lockwood is alleging that Horse Transporter Kerrie Cargill (K C Horse Transportation) is indebted to him in the amount of \$650.00 for transporting the horse 'Survived and thrived' (Trainer Blake Heap). Also present at today's hearing was Dan Cargill, who is the father of Kerrie Cargill. Safety Steward Paul Atkinson was also present.

The horse involved in this matter raced for Trainer Blake Heap at The Big Fresno Fair on October 14, 2016. Mr. Lockwood was involved in the sale of this horse following the race at Fresno. The horse was supposed to ship to Portland Meadows OR. but instead shipped to Bradbury, CA as originally scheduled before the sale. In a unanimous decision the Stewards dismissed this complaint. The Stewards suggested to Mr. Lockwood that another party in this matter may be billed but it shouldn't be Ms. Cargill. Possibly more to follow.

4/6/17⁵**SARAH RAMSEY**

K C Horse Transport (Vendor) filed a complaint against Owner Sarah Ramsey in the amount of \$4,323.35 for horse transportation services. Included in the complaint packet for this case were thirty one (CASE NO. 17SA0069)(31) pages of bills issued to Kenneth & Sarah Ramsey. Before this scheduled hearing K C Horse Transport informed the Stewards that this bill has now been paid in full and we subsequently dismissed this complaint.

4/6/17⁶**DEAN PEDERSON COMPLAINT (CASE NO.15SA168)**

The complaint in this case reads as follows: *On April 25, 2015 the horse "Go First" trained by Dean Pederson was entered in the 4th race at Santa Anita Race Track. The horse "Go First" was shipped from Los Alamitos to Santa Anita race track on April 24th, 2015. K C Horse Transport transported two horses from Los Alamitos to Santa Anita. Besides "Go First" there was a Martin Jones horse "Papa's Lass". Apparently "Go First" went to Martin Jones barn by mistake and was administered "Acepromazine" on April 24th, 2015 the day before the race. "Go First" was subsequently scratched from the race. See follow-up report for further details.*

Trainer Dean Pederson was here for this formal hearing along with his lawyer Steve Schwartz (Pasadena CA). Also present today were CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton, Sharyn Jolly (CHRB Administrative Hearings), Deputy Attorney General Vanessa Martinez (Los Angeles CA) and Court Reporter Michelle Derieg who transcribed the proceedings.

Trainer Pederson was fined \$400 in 2015 (REF:DM Ruling #88-9/7/2015) by Del Mar Stewards for violation of CHRB Rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration). This decision was appealed by Trainer Pederson in a timely matter on September 9, 2015. Also on September 9, 2015 the CHRB granted Pederson's request for a stay of the payment of fine. Some details on the original informal hearing on this matter are included in Stewards minutes at Santa Anita dated Saturday, June 20, 2015. Today's de novo (new) hearing now alleges two (2) rule violations against Trainer Pederson. They are CHRB Rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) and Rule #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse). Today's hearing lasted ninety (90) minutes and was adjourned due to time constraints. A second hearing date was scheduled.

FRIDAY4/7/17¹**AUSTIN SOLIS FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice Jockey AUSTIN SOLIS appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #1 Small Town Hero who finished seventh (last) in yesterday's (April 6) seventh race which was contested at 1 1/8th miles on the infield turf course. Apprentice Solis was accompanied by Jockey Mike Smith this morning.

In this race, Apprentice Solis was one of the races co-leaders at the 1/8th marker, when eventual second place finisher #3 Double Touch (GB) drove up inside of #1 Small Town Hero while making contact. The inner turf rail, which exhibited a good amount of give in this event, made it possible to pass Apprentice Solis at this juncture. Unfortunately along with contact to the rail this action also led to contact with Third place finisher #5 Broke Away Grey (Joseph Talamo) and sixth place finisher #2 Farley (Mario Gutierrez). Film review today shows Apprentice Solis drift in slightly and tighten up the racing room which existed at one time for Jockey Ocampo aboard #3 Double Touch (GB). Jockey Ocampo was also scheduled for film review of this race this morning. The Stewards' deliberated longer than usual following this film review. We issued a 'warning' in this matter. Our decision was unanimous. Apprentice Solis' most recent film review in our office was on March 17. (REF: 3/17/17²)

DAVID COTA COMPLAINT

A hearing was scheduled yesterday (April 7) for Owner David Cota who allegedly owes K C Horse Transport \$379.56 for horse transportation services. Owner Cotta failed to appear for the informal hearing. The Stewards issued the following ruling.

RULING LATS #117

Owner DAVID COTA, having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – K C Horse Transportation - \$379.56) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of DAVID COTA are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine). DAVID COTA is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

THEODORE LOVING VISIT

Former California trainer T.L. (Theodore) Loving visited the Santa Anita Stewards' office this morning. Mr. Loving told us that he was suspended about four (4) years ago in Iowa for allegedly letting a horse run loose that was in his stall but not under his care. Mr. Loving told the Stewards he is suspended in Iowa thru August 2018. He told us that he would like to return to race in California someday. He will need clearance in Iowa before that is possible.

GENERAL MANAGER VISIT

Santa Anita General Manager Joe Morris stopped by the Stewards' office this morning at our request. Several topics were discussed. Of particular interest to the Stewards this morning was jockeys' room security. An alleged recent theft, during the morning, has brought this matter to light. The rear door to the jockeys' room is at the jockey's room kitchen location. It appears to us that this door is being used when only the main jockey

room entrance should be utilized. Mr. Morris was receptive to our concerns and told us he would take care of the problem as soon as possible.

KEITH DESORMEAUX RULING

On Thursday, April 7 Trainer Keith Desormeaux called the Stewards' in the judges' stand. Trainer Desormeaux informed us that his clients had just sold the horse #1 'Vibe' who was in a seven (7) horse field yesterday April 7 (1st Race). This horse was also shipped out of state right after the sale. Trainer Desormeaux apologized for shipping his horse off the grounds after the race was already drawn. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

RULING LATS #118

Trainer KEITH DESORMEAUX who was scheduled to start VIBE in the first race on April 7, 2017 at Santa Anita Park, is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration – sold horse and shipped off grounds).

ISREAL OCAMPO FILM REVIEW/RULING

Israel Ocampo appeared in the Steward's office this morning in order to review his ride in the seventh race on Thursday, April 6. Safety Steward Paul Atkinson (Off Duty) sat in on the film review. He did not appear for film review as ordered yesterday April 6. The Stewards wanted to review Ocampo's ride aboard third place finisher #3 Double Touch (GB) in the seventh race on Thursday, April 6. In this 1 1/8 mile turf event Jockey Ocampo entered a tight opening along the rail and was involved in contact with eventual seventh place finisher #1 Small Town Hero (Austin Solis). Two (2) other horses received contact as a result of this incident (REF: 4/7/17(1)). Film review shows Apprentice Solis step in slightly in this race. The Stewards wanted to review Jockey Ocampo's aggressive ride that the Stewards' ultimately decided was not careless. Warning issued. For missing film review yesterday the following ruling was issued.

RULING LATS # 119

Jockey ISRAEL OCAMPO is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Office– failure to attend film review on April 7, 2017).

JUAN OCHOA FILM REVIEW

Jockey Juan Ochoa appeared in the office, along with his agent Susan McBrayer, in order to review his ride in two (2) races yesterday (April 7). Off duty Safety Steward Paul Atkinson was also present.

2nd Race April 7- Jockey Ochoa was aboard #4 Veronica Bay, who finished third, in yesterday's (April 7) second race. In the stretch drive Jockey Ochoa appeared to make contact with his riding crop contact around the ear area of his mount. Films were inconclusive and Jockey Ochoa was issued a warning for this ride.

8th Race April 7- Jockey Ochoa was aboard # 6 Son of the South, who finished fifth, in yesterday's (April 7) eighth race. At the ¼ mile marker of this one (1) mile main track event Jockey Ochoa used his riding crop four (4) consecutive times. Jockey Ochoa agreed with the Stewards' film analysis and the following ruling was issued.

RULING LATS #120

Jockey JUAN OCHOA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three

times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on April 7, 2017.

Mutuel Manager Randy Hartzell reported an all sources handle of \$20,855,004.70. Santa Anita Derby T-Shirts were given out to all on track patrons.

During the post parade of today's \$150,000 Providencia Stakes (Grade 3) #4 Beau Recall (IRE) unseated Jockey Joesph Talamo after she appeared to be spooked by something. This Simon Callaghan trained morning line second choice, ran off thru the open gap at the ¼ pole location. The Stewards subsequently scratched this horse. Safety Steward Ron Church checked on the horse in the stable area and reported that she was in good condition.

COREY NAKATANI FILM REVIEW

Jockey Corey Nakatani appeared in the film room today in order to review his ride aboard #3 Battle of Midway who finished second in yesterday's eighth race which was the \$1,000,000 Santa Anita Derby (Grade 1). In the stretch drive of this 1 1/8 mile main track event Jockey Nakatani uses his riding crop once left handed while on a drift. This action was the cause of contact with third place finisher #13 Royal Mo (Gary Stevens) inside the 1/16th pole. Jockey Nakatani corrected (straightened) his horse quickly after contact. The quick correction in this case likely spared Jockey Nakatani a sanction. In a unanimous decision, the Stewards' issued a warning.

GARY STEVENS APPEARS

Jockey Gary Stevens went to film room today in order to review his ride aboard #7 Princess Karen who finished seventh (last) in yesterday's Santa Anita Oaks (\$400,000 Guaranteed-Grade 2). Jockey Stevens was ordered to the 'film room' to review this race with the film analyst. However that racing official was unavailable at this time tending to other duties in the racing office.

We reviewed this race with Jockey Stevens in our office instead. Also in our office were CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton, Safety Steward Ron Church and Safety Steward (off duty) Paul Atkinson. Jockey Stevens was involved in a bumping incident with fourth place finisher #6 Majestic Quality (Kent Desormeaux) At the 1/8th mile marker in this 1 1/16th mile main track event. Stevens checked his mount sharply in this race following contact from his aforementioned rival who was 'locked in' in tight quarters. Jockey Stevens mount may have stepped in slightly at the point of contact.

WAYNE LOWE COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 17SA0073 – REF: 2/12/17¹)

Trainer Jorge Periban appeared in our office to in order to participate in a hearing that was scheduled to commence at 9:30 a.m. hearing. Trainer Periban alleges Owner Wayne Lowe is indebted to him in the amount of \$17,355.00. This is for thoroughbred training services from September 2016 to March 2017. Owner Lowe failed to appear at today's hearing. All attempts to reach Mr. Lowe have been unsuccessful. The Periban trainee, who is injured, was given to a rescue facility. The stewards' issued the following ruling.

RULING LATS #121

Owner WAYNE LOWE (dba Lone Pine Ranch), having failed to appear for two hearings, will be suspended on April 16, 2017 if he does not pay trainer Jorge Periban \$17,355.00 pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). Furthermore, the \$3,099.75 that Mr. Lowe has on account with the Paymasters at Santa Anita Park and Los Alamitos will be transferred to Mr. Periban should Mr. Lowe not appear before April 16, 2017.

RICKY AGARIE COMPLAINT (CASE NO.17SA063)

Pony Rider Karen Maclean filed a complaint against Trainer Ricky Agarie alleging Agaire owed her \$630.00 for ponying thoroughbred race horses to post. Ms. Maclean informed the Stewards that this bill has been paid in full and this complaint has now been withdrawn.

4/9/17⁵**JOESPH HERRICK COMPLAINT (CASE NO.17SA0070)**

The CHRB filed a complaint against Trainer Joe Herrick alleging violation of CHRB Rule #1866 (Veterinarian's List). The complaint reads as follows:

The horse 'Stormway' trained by Joseph Herrick was entered in the 8th Race on March 16th, 2017 at Santa Anita Race Track. Trainer Joseph Herrick's Veterinarian (Dr.Magrini) put in a "recommendation for a veterinarian scratch on March 16th, 2017 due to the horse 'Stormway' having respiratory illness. The horse 'Stormway' conducted a 5F work at San Luis Rey Downs in 1:02:60 handily on March 16th, 2017. Under Rule 1866 (B) (1) a horse placed on the veterinarian's list for being sick may not workout for 72 hrs. after being placed on the vet's list without the permission of the official veterinarian.

Trainer Herrick phoned the Stewards' office and pled guilty to violation of CHRB Rule #1866. The following ruling was issued.

RULING LATS #122

Trainer JOSEPH HERRICK who worked out the horse STORMWAY on March 16, 2017 (placed on the Veterinarian's List March 16, 2017) is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1866(b) (Veterinarian's List – may not work out for 72 hours after being placed on list {sick}).

4/9/17⁶**EIGHTH RACE INQUIRY**

The Stewards' posted the Inquiry sign after reviewing an incident involving second place finisher #4 Dr. Crabby (Iggy Puglisi) and fifth place finisher #2 Adrosa Sky (Edwin Maldonado) around the 1/16th mile marker of this 5 ½ furlong main track event. Race replays showed #4 Dr. Crabby drift in in front of #2 Adrosa Sky at this juncture and Jockey Maldonado checks his mount as a result of this action. Sufficient clearance on the part of Jockey Puglisi and #4 Dr. Crabby was questionable. #2 Adrosa Sky appeared to be tiring at the time of the incident. After receiving a patrol judge report, reviewing all replay angles and speaking to the two (2) jockeys involved the Stewards made 'no change' in the original order of finish. Jockey Iggy Puglisi was ordered to film review with the stewards.

4/9/17⁷**CARRER MILESTONE**
