Races: Eight races weekdays and nine races on weekends, unless otherwise designated.

Post time: Daily - 1:00 p.m. Weekends/holidays and Memorial Day, May 25, 2015 – 12:30 p.m.
Kentucky Derby Day, Saturday, May 2, Preakness Stakes Day, Saturday, May 16, Belmont Stakes Day, Saturday, June 6 – 11:30 a.m. Beginning May 22, 2015, Friday twilight racing – 4:00 p.m.

Scratch time: Regular scratch time will be at 10:00 a.m. the previous racing day, unless otherwise noted.
The deadline for scratches for stakes races, with the exception of overnight stakes races will be prior to the 3rd race or one hour before post time, whichever is longer.

Wagering: Minimum \$2 win, place and show wagering on every race; Daily Double on races 1-2, 4-5 and the final two races on each card. \$1 Rolling Pick Threes; \$1 Exactas on all races; \$1 Trifectas; \$1 and 10 cent Superfectas on all qualifying races; \$1 Pick Four on final four races; \$1 Pick Five on first five races; \$2 Pick Six (with carryover) on final six races, and \$1 Place Pick All (no carryover) beginning with first race.

STEWARD REPLACEMENT

Steward LUIS JAUREGUI will be in the office for the remainder of the week while Steward KIM SAWYER is out of the office. DAVID NUESCH will be taking over the duties as the safety steward for the remainder of the week.

4/23/15²**FLORES FITNESS HEARING (case number 15SA128)**

A formal fitness hearing was held today to determine if jockey DAVID FLORES would be eligible to ride in California. Mr. Flores is petitioning to ride in California after the Malayan Racing Association issued a ruling suspending Mr. Flores for one year from March 25, 2015, through March 24, 2016, for “failing to take all reasonable and permissible measures to obtain the best possible placing.” Present at the hearing were the Board of Stewards, court reporter MICHELLE DERIEG, Counsel PHILIP J. LAIRD representing the CHRB, accompanied by Supervisor Investigator RICK AMIEVA. Petitioning jockey Mr. Flores was accompanied by his attorney DARRELL VIENNA. After hearing all the testimony and entering the exhibits, the hearing was closed. Decision to follow.

FRIDAY4/24/15¹**STEWARDS INQUIRY/ DISQUALIFICATION (about 6 ½ fur. TURF)**

Following the running of the fifth race, the Inquiry sign was posted to review an incident approaching the eighth pole when the unofficial winner #3 GOUYEN (S. Gonzalez) came out causing hard contact with the fifth place horse, #5 DESERT STEEL (T. Baze). After speaking with the patrol judges and the riders involved, as well as reviewing the video several times, we voted unanimously to disqualify the #3 and place him behind the #5 (5th place). In our opinion the #3 came out causing hard contact with #5, would cost him the opportunity for a better placing.

SATURDAY4/25/15¹**SOLIS FORMAL HEARING - CASE #15SA0079**

The CHRB filed a complaint against trainer WALTHER SOLIS for violation of CHRB rule #1843(a)(d)(Medication, drugs and other substances), #1844(c)(1)(Authorized Medication) and #1887(a)(Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse). Present at the hearing were trainer Walther Solis, court reporter MICHELLE DERIEG and representing the CHRB, senior investigator PHIL MIYAZAKI. Mr. Solis started TIZ JOLIE in the first race at Santa Anita on February 13, 2015. TIZ JOLIE was reported to have tested positive for Phenylbutazone (4.33 ug/ml) (class “D” penalty) in the post-race sample. Mr. Solis stated he still is

puzzled how the positive had occurred. Solis hasn't had a Phenylbutazone overage in two years, which qualifies him for a "warning."

ESPINOZA APPEAL WITHDRAWN

The following ruling was issued after Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA withdrew his appeal of ruling LATS #062 issued for a riding infraction that occurred on March 7, 2015 at Santa Anita Park. Mr. Espinoza had been issued a three-day suspension for careless riding.

LATS #089

Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA, having withdrawn his appeal of ruling LATS #062 issued at Santa Anita Park on March 7, 2015, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (May 8, 9, and 10, 2015). All other terms of the original ruling shall remain in effect.

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races) the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

DEBT SATISFIED (CASE #15SA0093)

The following ruling was issued to reinstate Owner CHARLES SCOTT ZSEBIK after he satisfied his debt in full with vendor BRANDI GOODE, representative of FARMVET.

LATS #090

Owner CHARLES SCOTT ZSEBIK, having complied with the provisions of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – \$698.44 to BRANDI GOODE – FARMVET), is restored to good standing. Ruling #084, issued at the Santa Anita Winter Meet

JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

Jockey SANTIAGO GONZALEZ and his agent, CRAIG STEPHENS, were in our office to review yesterday's fifth race in which he was disqualified for shifting out causing hard contact with the horse just outside of him as they passed the quarter pole (6 ½ fur.) (Refer 4/24/15¹). Gonzalez stated that his horse was difficult to guide, but could have made a better effort when guiding his horse. We felt Mr. Gonzalez altered course too quickly and could have been more subtle. Consequently, he was issued a three-day suspension. The following ruling was issued:

LATS #091

Jockey SANTIAGO GONZALEZ, who rode GOUYEN in the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on April 25, 2015, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (May 1, 2, and 3, 2015), for altering course without sufficient clearance and causing interference, resulting in the disqualification of his mount from first to fifth position. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races) the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.
