FRIDAY01/24/14¹**FORMAL HEARING – CASE 14SA017, CASE 14SA018**

The CHRB filed two complaints, one against owner MARK MORAN and the other against his brother, trainer SHANE MORAN, for alleged violations of CHRB rules #1485 (License Subject to Condition and Agreements), #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations), and B & P Code 19435: "The Board, its executive director, or the stewards, may issue subpoenas for the attendance of witnesses or the production of any records, books, memoranda, documents, or other papers or things as is necessary to enable any of them to effectually discharge their duties, and may administer oaths or affirmations as necessary in connection therewith." This hearing is pursuant to the filed case #13DM0013 – CHRB rules #1902.5 (Animal Welfare) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing).

Attorney ROGER LICHT was retained as counsel by the Moran brothers. Supervising Investigator RICK AMIEVA faxed written subpoenas to Mr. Licht's office on December 13, 2013. The CHRB stipulated the information be returned no later than January 3, 2014, the failure to do so prompted today's hearing.

Present for the hearing before the Board of Stewards was trainer Shane Moran, accompanied by his counsel Roger Licht who is also representing owner Mark Moran. Court reporter Michelle Derieg documented the proceedings. Deputy Attorney General Elisabeth Frater represented the CHRB. At the hearing, Investigator Rick Amieva received the information requested in the subpoena and Deputy Attorney General Elisabeth Frater received her request for discovery. A telephone status conference is scheduled for January 30, 2014.

Investigator Amieva recommended a penalty be issued to both Mark and Shane Moran for their tardiness supplying the subpoenaed documents.

01/25/14²**MALDONADO RULING – LATS #022**

The following ruling was issued after the Board of Stewards was notified that the California Horse Racing Board rejected the Proposed Decision and elected itself to decide the Matter on a review of the record. The Board reinstated the Stewards' decision that Mr. Maldonado will receive the three-day suspension.

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO, having had the suspension imposed by ruling #48, issued at Hollywood Park Racing Association on July 12, 2013, reinstated by the California Horse Racing Board, is suspended for THREE (3) RACING DAYS (February 6, 7, and 8, 2014). All other terms of the original ruling remain intact.

The following ruling was issued after Mr. Reseigne paid his debt in full.

Owner ROBERT RESEIGNE, having complied with the provisions of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – \$378.40 to Southern California Equine Foundation), is restored to good standing. Ruling LATS #009, issued at Los Angeles Turf Club on January 3, 2014, is set aside.

01/25/14⁴**GONZALEZ RULING – LATS #024**

The following ruling was issued after Mr. GONZALEZ met with the Stewards to discuss his ride in the fourth race yesterday. Mr. Gonzalez acknowledged his overuse of the whip, apologized and stated it won't happen again. He was warned that a repeat of this violation would increase the penalty.

Jockey SAL GONZALEZ, JR., is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(5) (Use of Whips – using whip when horse is showing no response) while riding AGILA in the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on January 23, 2014.

Following the tenth race, the Inquiry sign was posted to review an accident. Approaching the 1/8 marker, #10 ELECTRIC EDDIE (M. Business and Professions Code Section 19481.3(e) provides that the stewards shall investigate and prepare a report regarding all on-track accidents involving jockeys that occur during the performance of their duties. The investigation shall commence no later than the next live racing day and shall be completed expeditiously.
