FILM REVIEW

Daniel Vergara called the Stewards after the fourth race was official on Sunday (10-23), stating that Mr. Gutierrez made it tight on him approaching the 3/8s marker. The BOS after a review of the videos and meeting with both riders felt that Mr. Vergara's horse appeared to be hard to control and was getting out. Mr. Gutierrez did not appear to be culpable for this incident, but was cautioned to be aware of a rider to his inside who might be in trouble; he promised to do so.

JOCKEY OBJECTION 7TH RACE (1 Mile Dirt)-NO CHANGE

Following the running of the race jockey Garrett Gomez who rode #6 Choquecherymary (3rd), lodged an objection against #8 Spirit Seeker (1st R. Bejarano) and #10 Ambitoness (2nd J. Talamo) for an incident after the start, before entering the first turn. Subsequent to a video review, conversation with both Patrol Judges and all jockeys involved it was a unanimous decision to make the original order of finish official. It was the Steward's opinion that #10 was not involved; #8 did drift inward causing #6 to steady and check after #9 Sambora (9th J. Rosario) shifted inward without sufficient clearance. Because #9 finished behind all involved a disqualification was not needed.

JOCKEY OBJECTION 8TH RACE (5 ½ Furlongs Dirt)-NO CHANGE

After the running of the race, jockey Joy Scott, who rode # 2 Thief River (4th), lodged an objection against # 8 lthoughtipaidyou (1st E. Maldonado) for possible interference after the start. Upon a video review, conversation with both Patrol Judges and both jockeys involved. It was the Stewards' opinion that #8 did drift inward and crossed the path of # 2 with marginal clearance. In the Stewards opinion #2 was not cost the opportunity of a better placing and the race was made official.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey Edwin Maldonado met with the Stewards to review the last race on Thursday, which involved a jockey objection. Mr. Maldonado agreed that his clearance when crossing in front of another horse was marginal. He stated that he would be more aware in the future and left the office with a warning. Reference 10-27-11³

Jockey Rafael Bejarano was in the office to review the start of the seventh race yesterday. After a review of the videos Mr. Bejarano was not held culpable for an incident approaching the first turn which involved an inquiry. Reference 10-27-11⁴

Jockey Martin Pedroza met with Stewards to discuss his ride in the first race yesterday. Mr Pedroza allowed his mount to drift outward in the stretch into another horse while using a left handed stick without an effort to correct. This infraction did not warrant an inquiry, and in a majority vote Mr. Pedroza was issued a warning for his ride. Steward Sawyer felt days were an appropriate penalty.

DOWD HEARING CASE #11SA135 & #11SA136

The two complaints filed against Joseph Dowd DVM by Official Veterinarian Jill Bailey involved alleged violations of CHRB rules 1842 (Veterinarian Report) and 1846.5 (Postmortem Examination). After much discussion about the issues involving the completion of forms for euthanizing horses, (name of Official Vet? is horse insured? was there

human injury?) Dr. Dowd was issued an official warning for his failure to comply, (case #11SA135) (rule 1846.5): Case # 11SA136 (Rule1842) was dismissed after Dr. Dowd explained how his reports were in fact faxed.

Near the 1/16 pole #4 Matlow (Tr. B. Headley) went wrong, fell and unseated jockey Martin Pedroza. The inquiry sign was posted to review the incident, but no other horses were involved and the race was made official. Accident report attached.

BANICKI RULING

PRTS RULING #034

Exercise rider ELIZABETH BANICKI, having failed to appear to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Elizabeth Banicki are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Ms. Banicki is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction

The above ruling was issued after Ms. Banicki failed to appear for the scheduled hearing.
