PERIBAN FORMAL HEARING CASE #11SA085

The complaint filed by the CHRB pertained to CHRB rule 1859.9 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding) pursuant to violation of rules 1844 (e) (9) (f) (Authorized Medication), 1843 (a) (d) (Medication Drugs and Other Substances) and 1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse).

The hearing was recorded by court reporter Barbara Weinstein, also in attendance were trainer Jorge Periban and representing the CHRB was Investigator Jim Hamilton. Vic Stauffer sat in as an observer. The owners Lucas Downs, Ltd. and jockey Jose Verenzuela were officially notified and they chose not to attend the hearing. The exhibits were entered into evidence and the hearing was closed.

The following ruling was then issued:

LATS #100

Acting on a report from the University of California, Maddy Analytical Laboratory, the official testing laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample #SA09681, obtained from the horse B'S LUCKY STRIKE, the second place finisher in the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on January 17, 2011, contained the drug Clenbuterol (Class 3) in excess of permitted levels, it is ordered that B'S LUCKY STRIKE be disqualified from all purse monies earned in said race, in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule 1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Finding).

It is further ordered that the purse money earned in said race (\$5,600.00) be returned by owner Lucas Downs, Ltd (\$4,760.00), jockey Jose Verenzuela (\$185.00) and trainer Jorge Periban (\$560.00) to the Paymaster of Purses at Santa Anita Park by April 26, 2011 for redistribution in accordance with the revised order of finish.

The revised order of finish is as follows:

2nd	No Stadium
3rd	Big Bad Boo
4th	Lucky Fritz
5th	Fantando

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1956 (Race Declared Official) neither pari-mutuel payoffs nor the distribution of any pari-mutuel pool shall be affected.

PERIBAN FORMAL HEARING CASE #11SA030

This complaint was filed by the CHRB against trainer Jorge G. Periban for violation of CHRB rules 1844 (e) (9) (f) (Authorized Medication), 1843 (a) (d) (Medication Drugs and Other Substances) and 1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse). Attached to the complaint was a stipulated agreement that was formulated and signed by Executive Director Kirk Breed, Chairman Keith Brackpool and trainer Jorge Periban.

The hearing was recorded by court reporter Barbara Weinstein; also in attendance were trainer Jorge Periban and representing the CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton. Vic Stauffer sat in as an observer. All exhibits were entered into evidence and the hearing was closed. The following ruling was issued after the agreement was approved by the Board of Stewards:

LATS #101

Trainer **JORGE PERIBAN**, who started the horse "B'S LUCKY STRIKE" in the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on January 17, 2011, having entered into a stipulated agreement with the California Horse Racing Board is fined **THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00)*** and suspended for **THIRTY (30) DAYS (March 28, 2011, through April 26, 2011)** for violation of rule #1844(Authorized Medication-Clenbuterol in excess of permitted levels) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887(a)(Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse).

Pursuant to the terms of the stipulated settlement, twenty days of the suspension (April 7, 2011, through April 26, 2011) are stayed provided that Respondent is placed on probation for a period of one (1) year from the date of this ruling. During the period of probation, Jorge Periban must not be in violation of California Horse Racing Board Rules and Regulations, sections 1843, 1843.6 or 1887 regarding Class I, II or III drug substances.

BROWN RULING CASE #09GG156

LATS #102

Owner **RAFAEL BROWN**, having satisfied the provisions of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility), is restored to good standing. Ruling #85, issued at Pacific Racing Association on May 9, 2009, is set aside.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Brown appeared with proof of meeting the needs of his financial obligations to San Francisco Equine, Inc.

DELEON RULING CASE #11SA065

LATS #103

Trainer **RAFAEL DELEON** is fined **SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750.00)*** for failure to properly report the gelding of the horse "MARGARITA SHOT", which ran in the ninth race at Santa Anita Park on March 6, 2011. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse).

This ruling was issued after trainer Rafael De Leon met with the Stewards and provided mitigating evidence that helped reduce the amount of his penalty. Mr. DeLeon's veterinarian did report the gelding on his confidentials, but Mr. DeLeon failed to notify the racing secretary and horse identifier, as required by the rule.

CANFIELD RULING CASE #11SA075

This case was filed by Official Veterinarian Jill Bailey alleging Cathy Canfield DVM was in violation of CHRB rule 1845 (e) (Authorized Bleeder Medication). Dr. Canfield admitted her failure to treat the horse Flemingstouchgold, trained by Ruben Gomez, with furosemide. This necessitated a late declaration of this horse on March 17, 2011. Mitigating circumstances were involved in the decision of the penalty, and the following ruling was issued:

LATS #104

Veterinarian **CATHALEEN CANFIELD** is fined **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)*** for failure to treat the horse "Flemingstouchgold" with Lasix in a timely manner, resulting in a late declaration from the third race at Santa Anita Park on

March 17, 2011. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1845(e)(Authorized Bleeder Medication).
