**10-06-10<sup>2</sup> FILM REVIEW**

Jockey **Leslie Mawing** was in to review his ride in the first race on Sunday, October 3, 2010 at Golden Gate Fields where his mount, WILMORE, broke slowly and did not improve his position throughout the race. While entering the stretch in last place, jockey Mawing whipped his mount trying to improve his placing. It is to be mentioned that trainer Bill Morey, Jr. had instructed him to take back if possible and then make his mount finish strongly. Jockey Mawing rode according to instructions given by trainer Bill Morey, Jr.

It is to be noted that trainer Morey had called the stewards prior to the film review stating he had given jockey Mawing these instructions. With this being said and jockey Mawing having no previous whip violations, stewards Moreno and Nicolo voted no sanction was warranted; steward Baker dissented. Jockey Mawing, however, was cautioned in the future not to use his whip as much regardless of the instructions from the trainer.

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to evaluate an incident at the 1/8 pole between #2 CHILLY WILLY (5<sup>th</sup>, James Wooten, Jr.) and #3 AKOYA BEACH (3<sup>rd</sup>, Pedro Terrero) where #2 CHILLY WILLY drifted into the path of #3 AKOYA BEACH.

After a thorough review the stewards let the order of finish stand.

Reviews of the race showed #2 CHILLY WILLY being beaten by #3 AKOYA BEACH therefore; there was no need for a change.

10-08-10<sup>4</sup>**RULING NO. 1 – HARRELL**

Trainer **DANNY L. HARRELL** is fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1895 (Trainers to Insure Licensed Participation) for violation of CHRB rule #1482 (Employment of Unlicensed Person) on July 5, 2010 at the Alameda County Fair.

The foregoing ruling was issued after the stewards heard Mr. Harrell's explanation of how he thought a groom he had hired to paddock a horse on July 4, 2010 at the Alameda County Fair (Pleasanton) was currently licensed.

10-08-10<sup>5</sup> **RULING NO. 2 – TAGLIAFERI**

Trainer **GENE TAGLIAFERI**, who started the horse **I'M A PRINCESS**, first place finisher in the fourth race on Saturday, August 14, 2010 at the Humboldt County Fair (Ferndale), is hereby fined five hundred dollars (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Unapproved Substance – Methocarbamol [Class 4]).

The above ruling was issued after the stewards heard Mr. Tagliaferi's explanation that he had no idea how his horse, I'M A PRINCESS, came up positive with the drug Methocarbamol. However, he did mention his horses were stabled in different locations throughout the barn area making it hard to supervise them.

10-08-10<sup>6</sup> **FILM REVIEW - RULING NO. 3 – WOOTEN, JR.**

Jockey **James Wooten, Jr.** was in to review his ride from Thursday's sixth race where his mount, #2 CHILLY WILLY, drifted in on #3 AKOYA BEACH. Jockey Wooten acknowledged he could have done a better job maintaining a straight course. Had #3 AKOYA BEACH not closed and beaten Wooten's mount, there would have undoubtedly been a disqualification.

After careful discussion and thorough review of the films, the stewards informed jockey Wooten of their decision.

Jockey **JAMES WOOTEN, JR.**, who rode **CHILLY WILLY** in the sixth race at the Big Fresno Fair (Fresno) on Thursday, October 7, 2010, is suspended three (3) racing days (October 15, 16 and 17, 2010) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The California bred or California sired race for maidens, two years old, one mile, claiming price \$12,500, failed to fill and went open with six head.

10-10-10<sup>2</sup> **RULING NO. 4 – OVIEDO**

Trainer **PHIL OVIEDO** is fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for failure to be in the paddock to supervise the saddling of the horse BLIND OPTIMISM in the seventh race on Saturday, October 9, 2010; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1894 (Duties of Trainer).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Oviedo was not present to saddle his horse. He took full responsibility for the error.

10-10-10<sup>3</sup> **OLIVO MALDONADO WARNING**

Jockey **Olivo Maldonado** appeared in the stewards' office this morning for whipping his mount in the post parade. As this was his first offense, a warning was issued.

10-10-10<sup>4</sup> **INFORMAL HEARING**

Trainer **Miguel Gonzalez** appeared to address CHRB case 10GG0206 which states on October 5, 2010 at 1906 hours, the trainer brought the horse PLATINUM TIME to the

Fresno County Fairgrounds from a ranch under false pretense. The horse was entered in the first race on October 6, 2010, post time 1315 hours. PLATINUM TIME was a late declaration as it had not been on the grounds twenty-four (24) hours prior to the race.

Testimony was presented and the stewards will take this matter under submission and a decision will be rendered in the near future.

10-10-10<sup>5</sup> **LOOSE MULE**

While the mules were warming up for the first race, #5 BARJF LUCKY TICKET unseated his rider, jockey Luis Godoy, and ran loose for 5/8 mile, then left the race course. The stewards had no recourse and had to scratch him. The refund amounted to \$13,927.40.

10-10-10<sup>6</sup> **ACCIDENT – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – Second Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign after viewing an accident in this race at, or about, the 1/16 pole where #6 LORD AGUILE bolted to the inside rail causing #3 BARRY SNOW MERRI to clip heels and stumble, unseating her jockey Olivo Maldonado, who was thrown heavily to the track surface. Maldonado was attended to by the EMT's and taken by ambulance to the hospital. It was reported #3 BARRY SNOW MERRI suffered no injuries.

After film review the stewards unanimously agreed to disqualify #6 LORD AGUILE and place him last and unplaced.
